GET STARTED WITH THIS ACTION CHECKLIST TODAY

- Align leadership around a *unified* digital vision**
 When leaders have differing opinions on objectives, transformation efforts can come to a standstill. It's essential to establish a shared playbook before you begin to scale.
- Identify 1-2 cross-functional transformation priorities**
 Focusing on a couple of key transformation priorities allows you to start small, which enhances credibility and makes the results more apparent.
- Identify areas where digital is treated as a side project**
 By pinpointing where digital initiatives are viewed as secondary, you can uncover duplication, hidden costs, and fragmented efforts that diminish overall impact.
- Appoint a Transformation Lead or Steering Group**
 Establishing ownership is crucial for driving momentum. Without it, digital initiatives may lose focus and direction.
- Evaluate current tools and identify overlaps and gaps**
 Before making additional purchases, take the time to assess what tools you already have in place and determine if they are being utilized effectively.
- Establish a 90-day goal for harmonising Business and IT Language**
 Misunderstandings between business and technology teams can stifle great ideas. Creating a shared language serves as the cornerstone for effective collaboration.

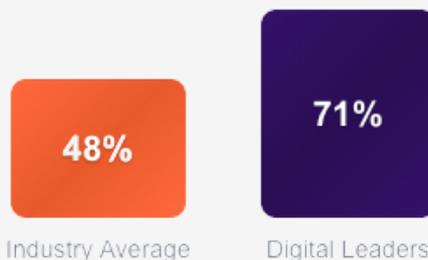
Digital transformation success is not just about technology. It is about *execution, alignment, and culture*.
